
Star Seed Australian Adventures

Itinerary

Day 1 Sydney

Arrive at any time. Friday, Sept. 30th

Arrival Day and Welcome Meeting

1hr Evening

The adventure begins tonight. Feel free to explore, but please make sure you're back in time for an intimate group dinner and welcome meeting with authors Judy Carroll and Helene Keye. Highly recommend that after a long-haul flight, you take time to connect with the earth and balance your circadian rhythm.

Day 2 Sydney

Free time to explore the many attractions. Saturday, Oct. 1st

Our star seed delegation will join UFOR, Sydney's UFO research group to meet and exchange wisdom with published author's, contactees, experiencers and open-minded attendees. Enjoy a panel discussion on Starseeds and Hybrids emphasizing galactic unity among star races. Judy Carroll, author of several books, including *Extraterrestrial Contact on Earth: A Lesson in History* will be presenting, alongside Helene Kaye, and American Starseeds. I will be sharing my Starseed experiences and awakening. Our group is encouraged and welcomed to share their knowledge as well.

The UFOR exchange is optional.

Day 3 Blue Mountains, a World Heritage Sight

Group time to explore the Blue Mountains or other attractions on the not so beaten path. Sunday, Oct. 2nd

The Blue Mountains are located on -33 degree latitude, an area known for UFO activity. We will visit Katoomba to view the iconic rock formation of the Three Sisters, lunch in the charming town of Leura and take in the sights of the Greater Blue Mountains, a World Heritage area.

Our final day will emphasize fun. Often, when exposed to new information, there is a process of integrating and assimilating, what better way to do that when having a good time in a supportive group environment.

Option: In Kootomba, we will glide the cliff tops on a glass bottom Scenic Skyway, the highest cable car in Australia, suspended 885 feet/270 metres above the rainforest ravine. \$39 AUD. Additional option to walk the bush trails to Echo Point.

Day 4 Sydney to Uluru

Group transfer to Sydney airport and pick up at Ayers Rock Airport. Monday, Oct. 3rd

Our day starts with a 3.5-hour flight to central Australia from Sydney. Our new home for four days and three nights is *Sails in The Desert*, a 5-star luxury hotel. Located just 15.4 miles or 24.8 km from Uluru, our delegation will be joined with our UFO Sydney friends as we set out by car to see the sunset at Uluru and an option to enjoy a group dinner in a field of lights. Is Uluru aligned with the heart song of the Pleiades?

Option: A Night at Field of Light, a 4.5-hour includes an introduction to the solar-powered artwork of Bruce Munro (think illuminated globes artistically arranged along the desert floor), sparkling wine and canapes at sunset from an elevated viewing area, extended time to immerse in the art installation and a three-course buffet dinner showcasing bush tucker ingredients as well as return bus transfers. Cost \$235

Day 5 Ulur<u>u</u>, a World Heritage Site

Explore Uluru. Tuesday, Oct. 4th

Our day starts with an early arrival to Ulur<u>u</u>-Kata Tjuta National Park. Group exploration or individual free time to explore the park, hike the perimeter of Uluru, view the Aboriginal art and enjoy the sensory experience of Ulur<u>u</u>.

Option: Travel to Uluru to witness a 6:24 am sunrise by car (free) or camel (extra). If you missed the 6:46 pm sunset on day 4, you now have an option to go by car (free) or camel (extra).

Included: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner / Accommodation / Park Entrance Fees/Transportation

Day 6 Uluru and Kata Tjuta

Explore Kata Tjuta. Wednesday, Oct. 5th

We will return to Uluru-Kata Tjutu National Park to take in the sites of Kata Tjuta (The Olgas), located 16 miles west of Uluru. Integration ceremony of all we have learned so far. For those wishing to explore Uluru more fully, an option to take in more hikes.

Option: Last call: Travel to Uluru to witness a 6:24 am sunrise by car (free) or camel (extra). If you missed the 6:46 pm sunset on Day 4-5, you now have an option to go by car (free) or camel (extra).

Included: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner / Accommodation / Park Entrance Fees/Transportation

Day 7 Uluru to Sydney to Macmasters/Copacabana Beach

Group transfer to Ayers Rock Airport and pick up at Sydney Airport. Thursday, Oct. 6th

Say goodbye to the dryness of Northern Territory and hello to the cool sea breeze of Central Coast of Australia. By car, we travel to our beach home situated within a coastal enclave of Macmasters/Copacabana Beach. This magical coastline is located between Bouddi National Park on the southern end and Copacabana beach on the northern end, with Cockrone Lagoon in the middle. *Bouddi* is an indigenous word for the heart. Here, we will connect with the land to integrate our travel experiences and recharge while taking in the panoramic sea views. It is not uncommon to spot Humpback whales and their calves as they travel along the Pacific coastline, which is locally called "the superhighway" for whales returning from birthing waters. Additionally, many bottlenose dolphins can be spotted in local waterways as well as the ocean.

Day 8 Macmasters/Copacabana Beach

Integration & Exploration. Friday, Oct. 7th

Time to find your perfect spot on the beach or enjoy the coastal rainforest, all within walking distance. A full day to integrate the energies and nurture your spirit by connecting to the land. We will be assembling for group meals where local hospitality comes out to greet and support you.

Day 9 Kincumba Mountain, NSW

Exploring Sacred Land from Ocean to Mountain. Saturday, Oct 7th

Our full day will include movement from ocean to mountain so that we can gain perspective about the land and its significance to the stars. Experience a walking meditation at

Kincumba Mountain, ceremony at a sacred women's cave, and story telling with our Pleiadian guide Nina Angelo. We are so fortunate to have our heart-centered guide to teach us about this sacred land, and to point out the land from the sea. After group dinner, free time to explore the beach and integrate new knowingness.

Day 10 Kariong - Gosford Glyphs

Light Hiking. Brisbane Water National Park. Sunday, Oct 8th

After taking in the sights of Gosford's city farmer's market, we journey on by car to see the Gosford Glyphs at Brisbane Water National Park. Our Pleiadian guide, Nina Angelo will share Aboriginal knowledge as shared to her by Aunty Beve Spiers, who was the last initiated Aboriginal elder and custodian of this land. How did aboriginal ancestors learn about star knowledge? And, why do they consider this particular site as sacred? We will take in the sights, learn the folklore, explore the monolithic tomb, and see many of the 300 glyphs caved into the rocks. You will see and experience Egyptian styled glyphs, ancient indigenous carvings and off-planetary glyphs of ships as well. From here, we will travel to see the Grandmother tree, more Hieroglyphs and above that, to the land where the women's Pleiadian healing table resides.
