Day 1 Edinburgh

Edinburgh Airport Transfer. Edinburgh. Monday, June 16th

Arrival Day and Transportation

Arrive at Edinburgh Airport (EDI).

Depending on your arrival time, a pre-booked shuttle airport will transfer you to our well-appointed hotel accommodations. To maximize your stay in Scotland, **please arrive before 3 p.m.**



Wash away the travel day at the **Dakota Hotel**, our lux 4-star hotel in the quaint village of South Queensferry. In your free time, explore the views of the River Forth and all three famous bridges, Forth Rail Bridge, Queensferry Crossing, and Forth Road Bridge, a 15-minute walk from our hotel.

Or discover Scotland's stunning capital and the vibrant heart of Old Town, Edinburgh. Explore Edinburgh's Royal Mile if you're in a material mood. Join the cue for Edinburgh Castle to take in the fortress with spectacular city views, £ 18 online or £ 21

if purchased onsite. Want more free views and options to work off those travel calories? Make your way up to Salisbury Crag, locally known as Arthur's Seat, for the 360-degree view from atop a mighty chunk of an extinct volcano. Maybe bring a few glazed, filled, sugar-dusted, or even vegan gems from Consider it Donuts...shush, no one's judging you if you decide to forgo the volcano hike but choose to discover the Kilted Donut instead.



Should rest and recalibration be your choice, unwind at the Dakota Grill, an open-plan dining experience, or retreat to our stylish hotel rooms for in-room dining.

We will be transferred at 5 p.m. for our welcome dinner.

Day 2 Rosslyn Chapel & Medieval Glen

Group Exploration. Edinburgh. Tuesday, June 17th

After a full breakfast, we depart for Rosslyn Chapel to experience the powerful lay line and discover the encoded secrets within the chapel. We will utilize the terrace café for lunch to ground ourselves before exploring the medieval glen below. Should you wish to explore the River North Esk and the surrounding glen, the path to the gorge below is steep, so appropriate footwear is required. This ancient oak woodland is also home to deciduous valley wood, rich in flora with over 200 species of flowering plants, 60 species of birds, stags, and red deer. During my exploration, I was surrounded by buzzing bees, sunshine, waist-high flowers, and native grasses. I am told there are fairies; this pristine forest is the largest surviving area of ancient woodland in the Midlothian area.

Whether in Rosslyn, Old Town Edinburgh, or the Dakota Hotel, dinner options are TBA and based on group desire.

Day 3 Arrival, Isle of Lewis

Group activity & individual exploration. Depart Edinburgh for Isle of Lewis. Wednesday, June 18th

Morning Flight: Departing Edinburgh at 7:20 a.m. and arriving at 8:20 a.m. in Stornoway.

Group transportation to Edinburgh Airport for departure to Isle of Lewis, an Outer Hebridean island where mountains, moors, grasslands, and stunning seas await our discovery.

To comprehend the essence of goddess culture is to grasp the fundamental elements of nature. In the Outer Hebrides, these elements communicate in their unique ways. Our forebears, who lived thousands of years ago, recognized nature's potency. They constructed stone temples that have withstood the test of time, with many meticulously aligned with the sun's trajectory, the moon's phases, and the stars' positions.

In our contemporary urban landscapes of concrete and steel, the comforts of indoor climate control and artificial lighting lull us into a sense of routine, making us oblivious to nature's forceful winds, her relentless surge of waters, and the intense heat of the sun.

Although we anticipate pleasant weather, nature will dictate our daily activities and exploration times. We might start early or extend into the evening to make the most of our island adventures, taking

advantage of the prolonged daylight hours. During our midsummer stay on the Isle of Lewis, the sun sets around 10 p.m.

Individual time is offered to discover the port town of Stornoway and have lunch. Before we check into our new lodging and recalibrate to our new island landscape rich with Gaelic culture, wildlife, locally sourced food, and ancient stones, we will gather delicious and ample supplies for our stay.

Day 4 Those Standing Stones! Exploring Callanish.

Group Exploration. Callanish Stone Circles | Tursachan Chalanais in Gaelic. Thursday, June 19th



Callanish is more than just a collection of stones; it's a gateway to a larger, interconnected megalithic landscape, a constellation of stone circles, arcs, alignments, and solitary stones, over 20 sites and 53 stones in total, each with its own story to tell. Erected in the late Neolithic area, Callanish standing stones were used ritually for at least 1,500 years, and it is here that we will deepen our understanding of a ritual landscape steeped in goddess lore. What will this landscape reveal or ask of you?

The goddess or Cailleach in Gaelic is no stranger to our Starseed Adventures; she appeared to one of our starseeds on our 2017 Ireland Adventure. On the morning of the autumn equinox, we were to depart for Newgrange, a Neolithic passage mound in Ireland that dates to 3,200 BCE. The Cailleach revealed herself wearing a luminescent white dress with long white braided hair. She shared a message that indicated Newgrange was "to Venus." Our starseed did not know that the lintel above the entrance of Newgrange was linked to Venus and its 8-year cycle through historical myth. Our starseed wouldn't learn this until our onsite visit with author Anthony Murphy. Newgrange is best known for its annual alignment with the winter solstice, when a narrow beam of sunlight penetrates the passage and dramatically illuminates the central chamber–today, visitors with a purchased tour ticket can experience the winter solstice through artificial light simulation. Today, some researchers associate the Moon and Venus with an alignment at Newgrange. Scholars Christopher Knight and Robert Lomas have demonstrated that the precise alignment and engineering of the light box at Newgrange indicate a rare occurrence: on a single day every eight years, the light of Venus enters the passage precisely 24 minutes before the light of the solstice sun. On Starseed Adventures, we never doubt the wisdom of the goddess.

I, too, have experienced *Starseed Adventure* moments, from Greece to Egypt, where the goddess reveals herself as a guide sharing information about our ancient history, temple alignment, and the power of nature's elements–all of which I continue to develop that experience-based wisdom into courses to pass the sacred bundle forward. How, if at all, will she reveal herself in Scotland?

To deepen our connection to our spirit, the ancient ancestors, and the Cailleach of the Moors, whose legacy is embedded in the landscape, it can take time to allow the busyness of mental chatter and travel expectations to fall away. Being spirit-led, we will return to the sacred sites during the day or night to become present and receptive to this ancient landscape.
